“Remember Lot’s wife”

- Matt. 24:17-18, 27-28 (Luke 21:28) (Dan. 12:11; Isa. 13:10; Dan. 7:13; Mark 13)
- Luke 17:32, 37
- We find, after careful study, this is not about the “end of the world” or the “rapture”, but rather about the destruction of Jerusalem.

“Remember Lot’s wife”

- Lessons:
 - The value of context: Matt. 24:36; 40-42
 - God’s plan comes about without warning to those who are unprepared: Luke 17:27-28
 - The danger of earthly cares: Luke 17:31-33; Luke 21:34-36
 - For Jerusalem, there would be signs...for the Lord’s Coming, there won’t...will you be ready? (Heb. 10:25; Matt. 25:13; 1 Thess. 5:2, 2 Pet. 3:10)
